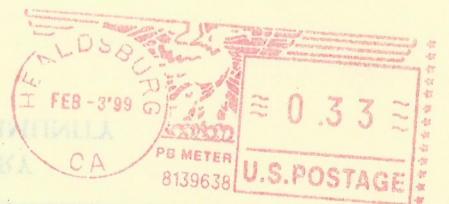

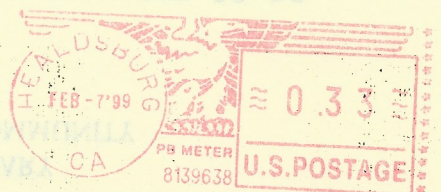

THIS IS YOUR LIFE (FR.) THOMAS W. DEVEREAUX

BORN APRIL 3, 1938, IN PORT HURON, MICHIGAN, ONE MILE AWAY FROM BEING A CANADIAN CITIZEN EXCEPT FOR THE BEAUTIFUL ST. CLAIR RIVER WHICH FLOWS BESIDE HIS HOMETOWN.

HE WAS FIRST KICKED OUT OF JEFFERSON PUBLIC SCHOOL KINDERGARTEN. THE NEXT NINE YEARS WERE IN LOCAL PAROCHIAL SCHOOLS FOLLOWED BY EDUCATION AT SACRED HEART SEMINARY IN DETROIT, ST. JEROME'S COLLEGE IN KITCHENER, ONTARIO, THEN SICK FOR THREE YEARS WITH STAPH INFECTION AND OSTEOMYELITIS IN HIS ANKLE. NEXT, HE WAS AN AUGUSTINIAN MONK FOR ONE YEAR IN KANSAS CITY FOLLOWED BY ONE YEAR OF JUNIOR COLLEGE (FOUNDED BY HIS FIRST COUSIN, ONCE REMOVED, TOM SIMPSON, AN ARROGANT AGNOSTIC).

THEN HE RETURNED TO THE SEMINARY IN 1961 AND GRADUATED FROM ST. MARY SENINARY COLLEGE, ST MARY, KENTUCKY IN 1963. (THE PLACE IS NOW A PRISON). THEN OFF TO THEOLOGICAL STUDIES AT MARYGLADE SEMINARY IN MEMPHIS, MICHIGAN, AND DARLINGTON SEMINARY IN NEW JERSEY. (MARYGLADE IS NOW A DRUG AND ALCOHOL TREATMENT CENTER. HE COMPLETED THEOLOGICAL STUDIES AT THE PONTIFICAL COLLEGE JOSEPHINUM, (THE WEST POINT OF SEMINARIES OPERATED BY THE POPE HIMSELF).

ORDINATION TO PRIESTHOOD ON JUNE 1, 1968 AT ST. EUGENE'S CATHEDRAL, SANTA ROSA. ASSIGNED FOR THREE MONTHS TO ST. ROSE IN SANTA ROSA, THEN 17 YEARS IN HUMBOLT COUNTY, WHERE HE WAS ACTIVE IN SOCIAL MINISTRY AND SCHOOL ADMINISTRATION. THEN FIVE YEARS AS PASTOR AT ASSUMPTION CHURCH IN FERNDALE, 6 YEARS AT ST. JOSEPH IN FORTUNA: BACK TO SONOMA COUNTY IN 1985 AS PASTOR OF THE 4 CHURCHES OF OCCIDENTAL PARISH, BODEGA, CAZADERO AND MONTE RIO. FOR THE LAST 9½ YEARS HE HAS BEEN PASTOR OF ST. JOHN'S IN HEALDSBURG. DR. DEVEREAUX IS ALSO VERY INVOLVED IN ECUMENISM AND INTERFAITH DIALOGUE AND ACTIVITIES. FR. DEVEREAUX NOT ONLY LOVES TO TEACH, BUT HE HAS CONTINUED HIS FORMAL EDUCATION. (A.B., S.T.B., M. DIV., D.MIN). HIS SISTER, MARY, ASKED HIM "HELL, YOU'RE 60 YEARS OLD AND YOU'RE STILL DOING TERM PAPERS?! HE HAS DEGREES FROM OR BEEN A STUDENT ON THE CAMPUSES OF CATHOLIC UNIVERSITY OF AMERICA IN WASHINGTON D.C., UNIVERSITY OF SAN FRANCISCO, NOTRE DAME, INDIANA, OXFORD UNIVERSITY IN ENGLAND, NORTH AMERICAN COLLEGE IN ROME, UNIVERSITY OF PORTLAND. HE IS PRESENTLY PURSUING A PH.D. IN PASTORAL PSYCHOLOGY.

HE ENJOYS TRAVEL, GOOD MUSIC, ART, ARCHITECTURE, READING, MOVIES, THEATRE, AND GOOD COFFEE, WINE, WHISKEY AND BEER, IN THAT ORDER WITH A GOOD MEAL. HE PAINTS, USED TO DO A LOT OF CARPENTRY AND GARDENING UNTIL ARTHRITIS AND DETERIORATING JOINTS MADE IT IMPOSSIBLE OR TOO PAINFUL.
